

arranged. It is also important that you find a space to park your car when bringing your child into school (please use Tesco car park and other car parks near to school). <u>Please do not stop your</u> vehicle outside the school gates to drop your child off in the morning, thank you.

We would like to remind parents that our PE kit consists of a navy-blue T-shirt (with or without school logo) and navy-blue joggers, to be worn with the Bodnant school jumper. Please can we ask that pupils do not come to school on their PE day wearing branded clothing.


