We have been working on how we move forward with our very successful community shop and are grateful for all the support members are giving us. The FareShare Community Shop can only work when everyone is being fair to each other.

This newsletter is to inform all members of our plans for the next few weeks and to notify everyone that we will need to address procedures regularly to manage the shop in the fairest way possible.

In the membership letter you will see that we ask, if you attend both days that you don't arrive early for both sessions, we will now be monitoring this to be fair to all members. Therefore, should you register on a Tuesday before 10:30am we would ask you to wait on the Thursday even if you arrive early and vice versa.

Please could we ask all members to be aware, we can only share out what we are given and that there is no guarantee of how much each member gets. Please continue to be fair and NOT cram your bags, only take what you can consume. Some people are expressing disappointment in quantity - can we respectfully explain that as a member you will need to accept some weeks are great and others are not so.

We have learned a lot from last year's pilot with the biggest lesson being that we did not charge enough. This is why it is £25 not £10. You will easily get over and above this as we will be covering certain costs.
