Educational Visits 2019



Nursery Trip ~ 'Lets Paint Pottery'

AM and PM Nursery pupils will be visiting 'Let's Paint Pottery' in Prestatyn for their end of year trip. 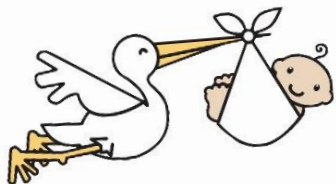
