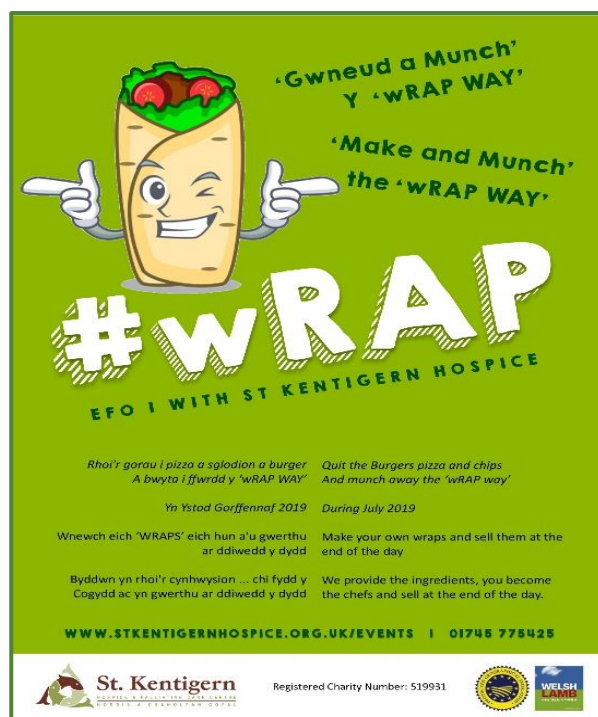
## 'Green Day'
