**8:50am Year 1** – no change to arrangements but please leave site straight away.

**9:00am Year 2** – will be met at the gate and taken to the soft play area by class teachers.

We are going to do this as a trial to see if the social distancing risks can be reduced. Please can you adhere to your allocated time and be mindful of social distancing with parents and staff.

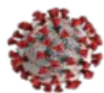

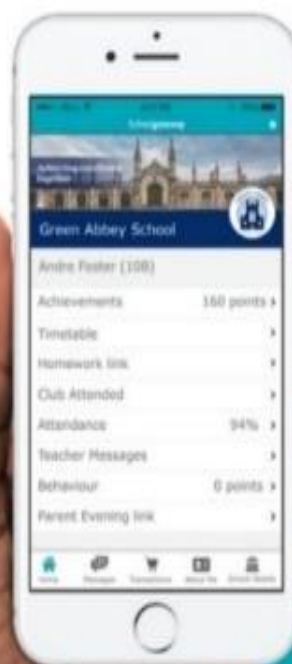
