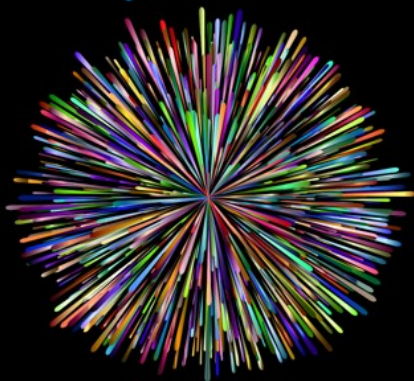


We are holding a day to raise awareness about the plight of our bees and share information about how we plan to help them in school by creating a **NECTAR GARDEN**.
