At the end of last term, the County advisor visited our school to meet the Criw Cymraeg and review all the work we have been doing to achieve the Gwobr Arian (Silver Award). This is an award for using and promoting Welsh culture and language in school. We were the first school in the County to be awarded the Gwobr Efydd (Bronze Award) in 2018 and if we are successful, we would be the first school in the county to achieve the Gwobr Arian.

The evidence has now been sent to Welsh government and we are very hopeful that we will have some good news to share in the near future.

On October the 15th it is 'Diwrnod Su'mae'. The idea is as many people in Wales greet each other by saying su'mae (How's things?) in as many places and contexts as possible. We are inviting pupils to enter a competition to produce a picture of a famous Welsh person (past or present) with a speech bubble saying su'mae. This can be drawn, painted or produced graphically on A4. All entries will be displayed in school and prize winners will be announced in the next newsletter.
