Bodnant Gardening Success



Keep Wales Tidy have recently been working with our school to plant hedgerows, around the perimeter of the school site. Once established they will provide essential habitats for wildlife, as well as creating natural screening. We have also received five fruit trees from the Tree Council, and these have been planted on the slope in the garden area. Our compost bin has been in use since October, to create compost from our garden waste. The work, so far, has gained our school Level 1 and Level 2 Gardening Awards from the Royal Horticultural Society Campaign for School Gardening. Well done to the children and staff involved, for all their hard work.

### **URDD 100 YEAR ANNIVERSARY 1922 - 2022**



Please sent entries to pw@bodnant.org by Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> March. Winners will be announced the following week.


Children will bring home a voucher for one of the free World Book Day titles, which should be available in Tesco.
