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




We will be celebrating World Book Day on Thursday 7th March.

Parkrun is a free, community event where you can walk, jog, run, volunteer or spectate. Parkrun is 5k and takes place every Saturday morning. Junior Parkrun is 2k, dedicated to 4-14 year olds and their families, every Sunday morning. Parkrun is positive, welcoming and inclusive, there is no time limit and no one finishes last. Everyone is welcome to come along and there are different courses all over the country.

Parkrun in Prestatyn takes place along the Nova prom. It takes place every Saturday at 9:00am. If you're really fast or really slow, you can still participate and run or walk at your own pace. It takes place at the beach prom behind the Nova. It doesn't cost anything but you have to register to get a barcode and then you just show up and you're ready to go. You run all the way until you go up a hill and cross some rocks and down a hill and you're back on the prom and you run to the end. When you get to where you started, you run more until you reach the beach hotel and you turn round right to the finish. My dad walks with my dog. Me and my mum run ahead and we run, jog and walk. 
